THE GOAL OF THE FUND FOR THE NEEDY IS TO ASSIST LOCAL PEOPLE IN NEED. THE FUND IS SUPPORTED BY FREEWILL OFFERINGS, DONATIONS MADE IN MEMORY OF LOVED ONES, AND THE ANNUAL GOLF TOURNAMENT. THE FUND IS A PARTICIPATING MEMBER OF THE SSCAC GREATER PLYMOUTH FOOD RESOURCES PROGRAM BUT RELIES ON THE GENEROSITY OF PEOPLE LIKE YOU FOR ALL ITS FUNDING.

THE FUND IS DESIGNED TO BE CASH IN AND CASH OUT. HOWEVER, A CONTINGENCY FUND APPROXIMATING ONE YEAR'S EXPENDITURES IS HELD IN RESERVE SO THE FUND CAN RESPOND IMMEDIATELY IN THE EVENT OF A SUDDEN ECONOMIC DOWNTURN OR LOCAL DISASTER. THIS YEAR THE FUND RESPONDED TO 2,094 REQUESTS FOR ASSISTANCE.

NOTE: THE ANNUAL GOLF TOURNAMENT USUALLY PLAYED IN MAY (FY 2016-2017) WAS RAINED OUT AND POSTPONED UNTIL AUGUST (FY 2017-2018). THEREFORE, THE NET PROCEEDS FROM THE GOLF TOURNAMENT ARE ASKEW. THE NET PROCEEDS FOR THE MAY, 2018 GOLF TOURNAMENT WAS \$31,165. THE NET PROCEEDS FOR THE MAY/SEPTEMBER, 2017 GOLF TOURNAMENT WAS \$33,800.

Thanks to your generous donations this fiscal year, the Fund for the Needy was able to assist 916 people in 303 households which included 341 children and 58 seniors.

Our food pantry had 1,991 visits and gave out over 10,000 bags of food. We distributed 210 dinners, with all the trimmings, to families at Thanksgiving & Easter. Through the Fund's "Family to Family Christmas Wish" program, we helped 108 families including 245 children receive the blessings of the Season.
