A Youth Lector undertakes a very important and public role within the parish community. As a Youth Lector, you will:

- proclaim the Holy Scriptures to the congregation and lead them to a deeper understanding of the mysteries of God and a more informed participation in the Eucharist;
- lead the assembly in the prayers of the faithful and express in those petitions the heartfelt needs of the whole community; and,
- proclaim the Scriptures with clarity and in a dignified manner.

Signed Agreement

As a youth lector, I pledge to the best of my ability:

- 1) to show up for the liturgical celebrations to which I am assigned;
- 2) to participate fully in the liturgical celebrations which I attend;
- 3) to work cooperatively with others in carrying out my duties; and,
- 4) to live my life in accord with the Gospel and in imitation of Jesus Christ.
